The award will be presented at the school's award assembly.

To be eligible for this award the student must:

- *Have been an active 4-H member for at least four years.
- *Have been awarded their 4-H charting pin.
- *Must complete community service outside the 40 hours required for graduation.
- *Submit a paragraph of 300-350 words describing your community service, tell what you did, the result, and the importance of community service.
